Condition Report

477. Generally good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear. Few minor dents, but nothing significant. So significant damage or repairs.

All six have 'AC' initials to front and 'L' above 'W.M' to backs, all with same two punch hallmark, comprising lion passant mark and HB maker's mark.

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
