An Edwardian silver cream jug of ovoid form, chased with flowers and foliate scrolls opposing spiral reeded decoration, on cast scroll feet, Sheffield 1901 by Elkington & Co, height 11.2cm, a Victorian silver cream jug, London 1868 by William Stocker, height 9.8cm, and another silver cream jug of oval lobed form, Birmingham 1898 by Samuel Walton Smith, total weight 285.1g.

Condition Report

416. Elkington & Co jug (centre of image) - small knock and bent section to the spout, otherwise good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear. No significant damage or repairs. Good clear hallmark to base.
Baluster jug by Stocker (right of image) - small dent to body just above front leg, otherwise ok with typical surface scratches and wear. Marks a bit rubbed but readable.
Birmingham jug (left of image) - generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks.

All three jugs sit flat without wobbling, no gilding to interiors.

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
