A Henry VIII silver maidenhead spoon, the tapered hexagonal stem with gilt maiden bust finial, the fig shaped bowl with crisp leopard head mark to interior, probably London 1513, indistinct maker's mark, weight 36.5cm, length 15.7cm.

Condition Report

457. Generally good condition commensurate with age. Typical surface scratches and wear. Typical minor nicks to bowl rim and edges of stem. Underside of bowl with scratches, some pitting and wear, some other pitting to stem. Typical wear to gilding on finial. Two marks a little indistinct. Leopard head mark nice and crisp.
