A Charles II silver Puritan spoon with slightly tapered rectangular stem, the oval bowl interior with leopard head mark, London 1663 by RF, weight 43.5g, length 17.2cm.

Condition Report

451. Generally good condition, typical surface scratches and wear commensurate with age, but no significant damage or repairs. Few minor nicks to edge of bowl. Good clear hallmarks, Leopard Head mark partially obscured. Pricked 'W.K' mark to back of stem.

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
