LOT 2033

A 16th century and later oak coffer, the hinged lid above a panelled front inset with gothic tracery panels, height 78cm, width 138cm, depth 66cm (alterations).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

2033. The majority of the coffer appears to be period but there have been some overall restorations and alterations over the years.

The hinged lid has later stap hinges, some inserted repairs to the wood and is missing its clasp.

The interior has had some replaced sections of wood in various places and had the candle box altered.

There is a possibility that the width of the coffer has been reduced as there are two replaced sections to the front panel on the right side and the outer edges of the two outside panels do not have a moulded edges to the carcass.

Overall typical historic woodworm and some typical cracks to some panels.

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
