A Second World War period RAF Operations Room Sector wall clock with single barrel timepiece movement, the backplate detailed 'Coventry Astral' and numbered '123', the 14-inch 24-hour circular painted sector dial with 'RAF' King's Crown Warrant Officer's insignia to the centre within a surround of black Arabic numerals and red, blue and yellow sector markings, within a circular stained tiger oak surround, case diameter 43cm, with winding key.
