A 19th century French ormolu cased mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the backplate inscribed 'Stevenard à Boulogne' and stamped 'Japy Frères' maker's mark, the enamelled dial with Roman hour numerals, the foliate scroll moulded lyre shaped case with fruit filled finial above cornucopia and flower festoon, height 32.2cm, with pendulum and two giltwood stands.

Condition Report

1153. Clock case ok with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear. A bit dusty and dirty.

Dial is cracked and chipped.

Not currently running.

Inside measurements for a dome 32.5cm x 15.6cm.

Outside measurements for a dome 33.7cm x 16.7cm.

Total height of clock and giltwood stand 39.3cm.

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
