A late 19th century Black Forest oak cased cuckoo mantel clock with brass two train movement with two bellows and striking on a gong, the dial with applied Gothic Roman hour numerals, the architectural case with carved and pierced decoration, height 63cm, with pendulum and winding key, together with a smaller cuckoo mantel clock, height 39cm, with pendulum (missing back panel).

Condition Report

1176. Larger clock is in generally good order. Typical scuffs, scratches, nicks and wear. Gothic '9' numeral missing. Both trains of movement wind smoothly, it strikes and cuckoo sounds as it should and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The smaller clock is not running, it is missing its backplate and case in poor order.

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
