A George IV silver pair cased keywind gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement and finely pierced and engraved balance cock with diamond end stone, the backplate detailed 'J.C. Morgan Cambridge', the white enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, Chester 1825, outer case diameter 5.5cm, total weight 144.9g.

1106. Outer case hinge is wobbly and missing locking clasp, so does not close securely.

Inner case with typical wear and surface scratches, but otherwise ok.
