LOT 1165

A Louis XV brown tortoiseshell and gilt brass boulle cased bracket clock by Leroy of Paris, the two train movement striking hours and half hours on a bell via an outside countwheel, the backplate signed 'Leroy Paris', the 9½-inch embossed gilt circular dial with applied enamel hour plaques and black Roman numerals, the waisted case with angel surmount above a glazed hinged front door and glazed sides, the interior with marquetry inlaid floor and back panel, the sides with cast foliate scroll mounts and feet, height 83cm, with pendulum and winding key, together with a matching wall bracket, total height 111cm (some faults and repairs).

Estimate: £500 - £800

1165. The clock is a little dusty and dirty so would benefit from a good clean, but otherwise in generally good condition.

Tortoiseshell is all intact and gilt brassware is all present.

Enamel dial with minor hairlines around one winding hole, but otherwise ok.

The clock winds smoothly and is currently running with strike mechanism working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
