LOT 1168

An early 20th century mahogany cased diminutive longcase clock, the German eight day movement chiming on gongs, the 5¼-inch brass breakarch dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Tho. Harben CLIFF LEWES', the hood with glazed door, turned columns and pierced fret panels, the slender trunk with hinged arch top door, on a panelled base and ogee bracket feet, height 141cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1168. Cosmetically the clock is in pretty good condition, typical scuffs and wear.

Horizontal splits to both sides of the base and a small shrinkage crack to top of the hood.

Movement all appears to be complete, but is quite dusty and dirty so would likely require a service and overhaul to return to full working order. It is also missing the suspension link section which supports the pendulum so unfortunately unable to check whether it currently runs.

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
