Four pieces of Trevor Corser St. Ives studio pottery, comprising a celadon glazed vase with four incised vertical lines, height 22cm, a dark brown glazed single-handled jug, height 17cm, a vase of yunomi type with ash glaze and combed vertical line decoration, height 9cm, and a tenmoku glazed circular pot and cover with incised line detail, diameter 13cm, each with impressed seal marks. Provenance: from the personal collection of the ceramic artist, the late Eric James Mellon (1925-2014).

Condition Report

The single-handled jug has a dark slightly soft substance around the handle terminals which seems to be covering firing cracks rather than any kind of break.

Otherwise the items in the Lot are in good condition with no damage or repairs.

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
