A Julian King-Salter studio pottery stoneware vase, 1995-2000, of baluster shape painted with cobalt detail against a predominantly turquoise erupted glaze of volcanic lava like texture, impressed marks to base, height 24cm. Provenance: property of a private Sussex collector.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

There are a few tiny lighter coloured spots to the outer edge of the foot which I would suggest are more likely to be unglazed areas rather than chips/nicks, one slightly larger is possibly a small nick.

There is a white pinhead sized burst air bubble to the glaze on the top rim edge.

Otherwise in good condition.

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
