A Janet Leach St. Ives studio pottery two-handled vase, circa 1987, the pear shaped body with trumpet neck flanked by two small loop handles, decorated with bands of speckled brown glaze, a small circle of running ash glaze to the rim, impressed seal marks to base edge, height 20.5cm, together with a signed and dated Janet Leach business card.

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no repairs or significant damage.

There are 2 minuscule glaze nicks to the neck rim edge which are almost probably potting issues and are incredibly inconspicuous and only noticeable on very close inspection with a keen eye.

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
