An Emmanuel Cooper studio pottery stoneware footed bowl, the flared body covered overall with a matt turquoise glaze beneath a manganese rim with gilt lustre splashes to the interior, impressed seal mark to base, diameter 16.5cm (restoration to rim). Provenance: property of a private Sussex collector.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

There are two areas of professional restoration to the rim where sections have been broken out and restored back, the first is approx 11cm long around the rim circumference and approx 4cm deep into the bowl, the second approx 5cm long and 3cm deep. They are only noticeable with a keen eye.

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
