A Peter Smith Bojewyan Pottery stoneware vase, the upper half of the cylindrical body with light and dark brown painted detail against a pale ground beneath a dark brown glazed rim, the unglazed lower body with textured surface, impressed seal marks, height 26.5cm. Provenance: property of a private Sussex collector.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

There is an approximately 5cm long vertical haircrack to the rim primarily visible amidst the crazing to the glazed interior - not really visible to the exterior. In addition there is a tiny glaze chip to the exterior top rim edge, just visible at 9 o'clock in image 5 on our website using the zoom function.

There are a couple of minuscule nicks to the rough edges of the unglazed relief work on the vase exterior - quite unnoticeable apart from on close inspection.

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
