Two pieces of Margaret O'Rorke studio porcelain, comprising a flared bowl with off white glaze, diameter 13.8cm, and a spherical pot and cover with pale grey glaze (base with haircrack), diameter 8.5cm, both with impressed seal mark, together with a studio pottery stoneware mug with vertical line detail, unmarked, height 10cm, and a Denis Moore studio pottery stoneware footed bowl with running ash glaze to the exterior rim over a brown glazed body, impressed seal mark to underside, diameter 13cm. Provenance: from the personal collection of the ceramic artist, the late Eric James Mellon (1925-2014).
