A John Maltby semi-porcelain studio pottery bowl, of flared circular shape raised on a small circular foot, the exterior painted with three red crosses and gilt dots in three squares against a tenmoku ground, white glazed interior, impressed seal mark to outer edge of footrim, diameter 14cm, together with a square stoneware dish resist decorated with a pattern of squares to the base interior, unmarked, 30cm square. Provenance: property of a private Sussex collector.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

Bowl has very small nicks to entire circumference of foot, almost more easily felt than seen, otherwise in good condition with no damage or repairs.

Dish in good condition with no damage or repairs, overall light surface scratches to glazed interior.

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
