SLAVERY. ♦ [Anthony BENEZET.] *The Case of Our Fellow-Creatures, the Oppressed Africans, Respectfully Recommended to the Serious Consideration of the Legislature of Great-Britain, by the People called Quakers.* London: James Phillips, 1784. First printing, 8vo (223 x 148mm.) Title, 15pp. text with publisher's advertisement verso last leaf. (Marginal creasing and dust-soiling.) Original blue wrappers, string-bound (fading). Note: Anthony Bezenet was a prominent member of the American abolitionist movement and set up one of the first anti-slavery societies.

Condition Report

3008. Complete and in original blue paper wrappers. Not bound. Wrappers have some marginal fading and small corner creases.

Title page has larger corner creases, approx 1-2cm, and dust soiling to the edge. Similar corner creasing to 3 more leaves, but less dust soiling. The last four leaves are cleaner because they have a cut and smaller outer edge.

The string and binding is firm.

Overall, well preserved.

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
