A Native American Navajo squash blossom necklace by Harry Morgan (1947-2008), mounted at intervals with a variety of turquoise and shell, otherwise with beaded links and a central naja pendant, detailed 'H. Morgan', otherwise unmarked, weight 114.3g, length 57cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

In generally good condition overall.

When looking under a 10x loupe there is some very minor scratching to the surface of the turquoise and shell but this isn't noticeable with the naked eye.

Some typical light scratching/scuffing to the silver.

One or two very minor dents to the silver spherical beads, but hardly noticeable.

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
