A pair of Second World War period 15x80 binoculars by Ross, London, dated 1944, mounted on their folding tripod stand with adjustable pull-out leg extensions, together with a pair of Carl Zeiss rabbit-ear binoculars.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

4291. Zeiss - binoculars are very dirty. Both lenses look relatively clean to look through. Left-hand side prism from the other direction appears to have considerable environmental flaws. Hard to focus.

Relic condition, with potential.

Ross binoculars on stand - lenses in good general condition. Possibly a few internal spots, environmentally they appear poorly stored in more recent times. No apparent internal damage and appear very good visually when used.

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
