LOT 645

A group of largely Native American Navajo silver mounted jewellery, comprising a cuff bracelet by Tommy Moore, mounted with alternating turquoise and shell, signed and detailed 'Sterling', inside width 5.6cm, a turquoise ring by Alvin Joe, detailed 'AJ Navajo Sterling', three further rings, a turquoise set brooch and a pair of heart shaped earrings, mounted with shell and turquoise, total weight 133.8g, together with a single row necklace of turquoise beads, with a box detailed 'San Diego, CA'.

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

Bangle - some wear to the turquoise and shell, more so to the shell, no cracks or chips.

Brooch - pin and catch in working order

Larger green turquoise ring - some noticeable scratching to the surface of the stone, with dirt build up within the cracks

Marquise shaped turquoise ring - chips to two of the turquoise, but stones appear secure within their settings

Shell panel ring - minimal wear to the shell

Oblong turquoise ring - minimal wear

Pair of earrings - lacking butterflies, some discoloration to the silver around the turquoises, the turquoises differ in colour which is quite noticeable

Turquoise beads - diameter range 10.8mm to 11.5mm, some natural colour variation, no obvious chips to the beads

Overall, some light scratching to the silver on all pieces, to be expected with age.
