A gold, enamelled, seed pearl and diamond bar brooch of lobed form, mounted with a single seed pearl between two old cut diamonds against a pale blue enamelled ground within a white enamelled border, unmarked, weight 4.9g, width 3.9cm, with an associated R & S. Garrard & Co. case.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

A little dirt has built up around the edges of the blue enamel, will benefit from a clean.

There are a few scratches and small nibbles to the white enamelled border, these are however largely only really noticeable when viewing the piece under a 10x loupe.

The pearl is in good condition, with no signs of peeling.

Diamonds appear secure within their settings.

The pin and hook fittings are both slightly bent out of position, meaning the piece can not be fastened securing at present. Hinge ok.

The case is in generally good condition.

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
