A William IV rosewood wine table attributed to Gillows of Lancaster, the rectangular top with gadrooned border, on a turned column with carved tulip cusp stem and triform base, height 75cm, width 56cm, depth 44cm. Provenance: from the estate of a Sussex gentleman.

Condition Report

2001. Some overall slight bleaching of colour and some minor surface scratches to top, but otherwise the table is in good original condition with some minor surface wear and very minor knocks to edges. Also worth noting is the slight gapping between the beading and the edge of the top in two corners.

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
