A Regency bird's eye maple and foliate inlaid library table, in the manner of Gillows of Lancaster, the moulded top above two frieze drawers, twin supports and four cabriole legs, finely carved with acanthus leaves, terminating in castors, height 72cm, width 130cm, depth 68cm.

Condition Report

2012. The top has some thin cracks to the veneer on the borders on each side, as well as some surface marks and minor scratches. A few pieces of the half-round mouldings on the lower edge of the frieze have been replaced. Both supports have some drying-out cracks through them and there is some lifting and loss to the veneer on each of the rounded surfaces of the lower section of each support.

Otherwise in general appearance and condition is quite good.

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
