LOT 339

A late 19th/early 20th century Chinese silver two-man rickshaw condiment stand, modelled as a central wicker-effect section fitted with a mustard and spoon, salt and pepper caster, flanked by two men, each standing on a wheeled platform, maker's mark for Wang Hing, weight 242.2g, length 21cm, height 11cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

339. The condiment stand is in generally good condition, with just a few minor faults.

One of the carrying bags being detached from each figure (they still rest in place, but would originally have been soldered).

Some simulated rope missing from around the basket and one side of the seat has a small hemi-spherical finial to one side which is not replicated on the other side.

It is also rather dirty and would benefit from a clean.

Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

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
