An early Victorian saddle-ring percussion cavalry carbine with front and rear-sighted round barrel, barrel length 51cm, full-stocked with brass furniture, line border engraved steel lock, marked with crowned 'V.R.' and 'Tower 1847', and pull-out swing-over steel ramrod (actions works at full and half-cock, loss to woodwork near muzzle, some general bruising, overall an honest piece).

Estimate: £400 - £500

Condition Report

4022. Half and full cock works nice and tight. Some bruising to stock areas and throughout, but nothing detracting in our opinion. Loss to woodwork at muzzle area. Stamped faintly to stock J & E Hollis, some odd numbers stamped but hard to work out.

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
