Condition Report

2027. The condition generally is quite good, but does have surface of slight mildew and blooming, having been in store for nearly two years.

The top has the typical marks and old scratches, but does have a few old closed cracks to the edges.

The two leaves appear to be good, but later replacements.

There have been some alterations to the understructures below the tops and the central lock is different to the two end locks. The castors appear to be later replacements.
