A pair of Chinese famille verte export porcelain vases and covers, Kangxi period, each baluster body moulded with panels painted with figures, flowers, ducks and lotus, height 31.4cm (one with repairs, the other with two hairlines to rim).

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

1050. Vase 1 - Generally good condition, with no significant damage or repairs.

There are three 3cm hairline cracks to the rim. Otherwise the body of the vase is in good order with no cracks or repairs.

Enamels are bright and vibrant with some surface scratches and wear to decoration and glaze.

Small chip to inside of footrim.

Cover in good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

Vase 2 - The body has been broken into numerous parts with significant damage and repairs to the neck and body with some filling and overpainting along the breaks. The restoration is looking tired and flaking so would require full restoration.

Enamels bright and vibrant.

Typical surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze.

Cover in good condition, typical surface scratches and wear.

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
