Condition Report

1035. The vase is in generally good decorative condition.

5cm vertical hairline crack to the rim.

Cover has had a section of rim broken, reglued with overpainted restoration.

Typical glaze fritting around edge of foot.

Typical surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze.

Some minor enamel loss.
