A Chinese black silk embroidered rectangular dragon panel, late Qing dynasty, finely worked in coloured and gilt threads with three dragons, flaming pearls and vapours above rocks, crashing waves and Buddhist emblems, on a black ground, 63.5cm x 150cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £200 - £400

Condition Report

1170. The panel is in generally good condition. The colours are bright and vibrant, and the quality is very good. Some minor unstitching in places, more pronounced to the gilt thread on the waves, particularly to the centre. Black ground is generally good with some minor marks, scuffs and dirt specks, but nothing too significant. The black outer border has some tears, holes and more significant wear, but does not affect the main panel as it is a stitched border.
