A small group of Chinese porcelain, comprising a famille rose export porcelain mug, Qianlong period, painted in the Mandarin palette with a figural scene, height 12.2cm (cracked), a famille rose export porcelain punchbowl, Qianlong period, painted with birds and flowers, diameter 26.2cm (cracked), a blue and white porcelain circular dish, Ming dynasty, decorated with a foliate design, diameter 25cm (repaired), and a famille rose enamelled small jardinière, Republic period, painted with fenghuang, rock, peony and prunus, height 10.3cm.

Condition Report

1082. Mug - 7cm hairline to rim and few minor rim scuffs to glaze, otherwise good condition with bright vibrant enamels.

Jardiniere - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light wear to gilt and enamels.

Blue and white dish - broken into 4 pieces and reglued. Typical surface scratches, wear and glaze crazing.

Bowl - four hairline cracks to the rim (4.5cm, 6cm, 7cm, 8cm long), also minor chips and glaze fritting to rim.

Typical surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze.

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
