A Japanese cloisonné koro and cover, Meiji period, of globular form, decorated with panels of butterflies and flowers on a gilt whorled and mon-filled black ground, on tripod feet, height 10cm (finial repaired), together with a cloisonné box and cover, 20th century, of wing form, length 12.1cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1064. Koro - body in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical surface scratches and wear.

The cover is a good fit, but the finial has been broken and reglued in place, with some loss to enamels in this area.

Wing box - generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. A little dusty and dirty so would benefit from a clean. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

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
