LOT 548

An early 19th century gold, amethyst and half-pearl set pendant, collet set with the cushion shaped amethyst within a surround of graduating half-pearls, the back with a hinged locket compartment, otherwise inscribed with a mourning inscription and dated '1831', unmarked, weight 3.3g, length 2.4cm, with a gold twin bar and oval link neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed '9ct', weight 1.7g, length 37cm.

Estimate: £160 - £190

Condition Report

One or two pearls showing signs of peeling, some slight variation in lustre to the pearls, silvery/creamy

Some scuffing/scratching to the glazing on the back of the pendant.

Boltring clasp to the chain is slightly bent, the mechanism works but doesn't always secure into place correctly when in the closed position.

Otherwise in fairly good condition overall.

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
