Condition Report

378. Generally good condition.

Diagonal split to one bottom corner of a side panel (see image 4 on our website). Otherwise tortoiseshell panels in good order.

Mounts all present and in good order. No marks.

Hinged back door in good working order, closes tightly and clasp is good.

Glass front with deep scratch at 10 o'clock.

Dial appears to be in good condition.
