A fine E.M.G. Handmade gramophone with mechanical winding handle, tri-spoked soundbox and large papier-mâché horn, the oak case with ebony stringing and crossbanded borders, diameter of horn 74cm, width of case 52cm, together with a small group of accessories.

Estimate: £2,000 - £4,000

Condition Report

2575. The winding handle and turn appear to operate correctly.

The exterior of the case has some minor surface scratches and marks, but is in generally good order.

The horn has some scuffs and surface loss to the rim of the bell and some overall surface wear.

The interior has a small section of oak veneer missing.

The turntable edge and some of the metalwork is a bit oxidized, but otherwise the condition is reasonable.

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
