Condition Report

380. Small repair of shell at front tip next to the rim and a hairline crack to the shell near the back. Otherwise, silver in generally good condition, with good hinge and lid closing tightly. Typical light surface scratches and some wear to engraved monogram and scrolls. All these condition issues can be seen in the images on our website.

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
