Condition Report

2563. Raised area and small chip near Japan.

Long surface crack and repainting across the Arabian Sea and Indian Ocean.

Cracks and repainting around equator above South Atlantic.

Some overall foxing scattered throughout, two pieces of crossbanded veneer missing to edge of ring.

One replaced stretcher to stand.
